## Street Maintenance Sales Tax

The City of Rollingwood City Council has prioritized investing in the city's infrastructure through the improvement, rehabilitation and reconstruction of streets in Rollingwood.

### TAX CODE CH. 327.006

The State of Texas allows municipalities to collect a sales and use tax exclusively for the maintenance and rehabilitation of existing public streets.

### IF APPROVED

The collection of 1/4 of one cent street maintenance sales tax is expected to generate approximately \$150,000 annually. The City has collected over \$1.3 million from the sales and use tax since it was authorized in 2009.



### HISTORY

The Street Sales Tax was first authorized in Rollingwood in November 2009 and was reauthorized in 2013 and 2017. The Tax Code requires the voters to reauthorize the tax every four years.

### FACTS

Non-Residents who purchase goods in the City of Rollingwood would share the cost in maintaining/repairing city streets through the street maintenance sales tax.
