

Keeping It Neat and Green MS4 and Lawn Care Guide

Whether you're a do-it-yourselfer or you hire assistance, please be mindful of your neighbors and the environment when it comes to your lawn care.



- Do not blow lawn trimmings onto your neighbors'
 yards or in the street. Instead, leave it as
 fertilizing mulch or bag it with leaves and set it
 out for collection. Neighbors don't want your
 mess, and the lake can't handle your runoff.
- Don't over-water. Consider limiting your sprinkler zone timers to 15 minutes or less per zone.
 Handwater flowerbeds or use a soaker hose instead of a sprinkler.
- Let the bees be! Please use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly. Use organic mulch or safe pest control methods whenever possible.
