ROLLINGWOOD LAWN CARE GUIDE

Whether you're a do-it-yourselfer or hire assistance, please be mindful of your neighbors and the environment when it comes to your lawn.

- Do not blow lawn trimmings onto your neighbors or in the street. Instead, leave it as fertilizing mulch, or bag it in brown paper bags with leaves and set it out for collection.
- Refrain from over watering. Consider limiting your sprinkler zone timers to 15 minutes or less per zone. Handwater flowerbeds or use a soaker hose instead of a sprinkler. Refer to additional local water restrictions for further guidance.
- Let the bees be! Please use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly. Organic mulch or chemical free pest control methods are gentler on our pollinators.
- Rollingwood's trash service will collect up to 4 bags of leaves, clippings, and brush on a single collection day. Limbs cut to 4' lengths and bundled with degradable twine will also be collected. Please use paper lawn bags available at grocery and hardware stores, and do not put them in your dumpster.
