

# Solid Waste Service Guide

## TRASH COLLECTION

- Residents provide their own container for trash.
- Containers no larger than 45 gallons or weighing more than 50 lbs
- Please put your normal household trash items inside your trash cart
- Please place your carts at the curb for collection before 7 am every **MONDAY & THURSDAY**
- Each service day you may place out your trash container + up to 3 kitchen trash bags (13-30 gal each) or yard waste bags/bundles next to your container.
- Please do not overload your container (by weight or volume). Over loaded carts will NOT be serviced.
- Please DO NOT put medical waste, hazardous waste, explosives, flammable liquids pesticides, or animal carcass in the cart or on the curb for collection.
- Please DO NOT put any construction material, dirt, rock, or yard waste in your cart

## Cart Placement Guidelines

To ensure our trucks can safely collect your trash and recycling, please adhere to the following guidelines.

Avoid placing carts under trees and power lines



Please place all containers no more than 3ft from the road for service



Please place your cart out before 7am on collection days



Make sure no cars are parked in front of your containers



For our safety, please keep carts weight under 80lbs

## RECYCLE COLLECTION

- Recycle is serviced weekly on **THURSDAY**
- Please have carts curbside by 7 am on the service day
- Recycle service is cart contents only. All recyclables must be inside the cart.
- Recycle that is placed outside the cart is considered an unacceptable item & will be serviced as trash.

• All Items Must Be **INSIDE** The Cart

• Place Your Cart At Least **5 Feet** From Your Trash Cart
