

Rollingwood Community Education Garden Proposal

Objectives:

Create a small communal garden to become an essential part of a vibrant, livable and sustainable city.

Help unite neighbors, contribute to neighborhood beautification and connect citizens with the outdoors.

Facilitate communication, foster intergenerational and cross-cultural connections and encourage physical activity.

Create an educational venue for discussions on sustainability and self-reliance.

Provide seasonal gatherings through community harvests and feasts.

Details:

-20' x 40' fenced and locked garden plot on the north end of the lower playground field.

-Built and maintained by RW resident's contributions and volunteerism.

-Water to be provided by City of RW as area is currently irrigated by the City. Garden is expected to decrease current water use. A water collection system will be installed to provide majority of garden's water needs.

-Any RW resident can participate by signing an agreement to Rules & Regulations and a Waiver of Liability.

-Garden is communal with no individually maintained plots. Plots will be designed by a certified permaculture gardener to maximize plot yields and sustainability year round.
