ORDINANCE NO. 2017-09-20 (B)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS, ADOPTING AND APPROVING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND TERMINATING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018 AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PROJECTS AND ACCOUNTS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the annual city budget, appended hereto as Exhibit A, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2017 and terminating September 30, 2018, was duly presented to the City Council by the City Administrator, and a public hearing was ordered, a public notice of said hearing was caused to be given, said notice was published in the Westlake Picayune, and said public hearing was held according to such notice:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. Subject to the applicable provisions of State law, the budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2017 and terminating September 30, 2018 as filed with the City Secretary of the City of Rollingwood and adjusted by the City Council of the City of Rollingwood and attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, containing estimates of resources and revenues for the year from all various sources, and projects, operations, activities, purchases, payment of debt, and other expenditures to be undertaken during the year, together with estimates of cost thereof, and estimated amounts of proposed expenditures, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Expenditures shall be as hereby appropriated from the funds indicated and for such purposes, respectively, in such sums of money as may be required for the accomplishment of each of the projects, operations, activities, purchases, payment of debt, and other expenditures proposed in such budget, not to exceed for each such category of expenditure, the total amount provided for such category of expenditure.

SECTION 3. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon approval and adoption by the City Council.
