CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 2014-12-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS AMENDING CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES ARTICLE 13.03.006 TO PROVIDE FOR A CHARGE FORRECYCLING BINS IN EXCESS OF ONE AND FOR SUCH ADDITIONAL SERVICEPROVIDED; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. City Code of Ordinances Section 13.03.006 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Sec. 13.03.006 Payment of costs of residential collection service

- (a) The cost of residential solid waste collection service will be paid by the city out of the municipal general fund.
- (b) The city may from time to time arrange for the collection of recyclable materials in the city by solid waste collection providers. Whenever collection of recyclable materials is arranged and an option for multiple recycling bins is made available to residents, a utility account holder may elect to have additional recycling bins. The cost or charge imposed by the service provider for additional recyclable materials bins and collection thereof shall be passed on to the utility account holder for the address of service. Fees shall be paid by the account holder on a monthly basis. The City Administrator or his/her designee shall promulgate forms and procedures for establishing an account for such additional recyclable materials collection, determining the fee payable, payment of fees by the customer, and enforcement of fees, including procedures for discontinuation of service in the event that fees are not timely paid.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

<u>Section 3</u>. If any provision of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, such void or unenforceable provision shall be severed as though it never formed a part of this Ordinance, and all other provisions hereof shall remain in full force and effect.
