The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted as statements of legislative intent of the City Council and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Resolution No. 2010-09-28(A) is hereby amended and the budget for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2011 is hereby changed for municipal purposes in order to authorize the following:

Move \$43,000 identified in the original budget under account (or line item) No. 13010-Fund Balance. Account 40-1760 Police Car & Accessories shall be increased for the reallocation of budgeted authorization for municipal purposes.
