6. Discussion and review of the Open Meetings Act as it pertains to the Park Commission and City Council Liaisons

Assistant City Administrator Ashley Wayman discussed the Open Meetings Act as it pertains to the Park Commission and City Council Liaisons.

Mary Elizabeth Cofer stated that she would get back with the liaisons next week regarding whether she would like the attorneys to do a more in depth presentation.

7. Discussion and possible action to address erosion and maintenance issues on existing crushed granite trail in the park, to investigate possible stabilizing surfaces or materials, and to address a connection trail from the upper to the lower park

The commission discussed stabilizing materials to use on the park trail and the preliminary connection trail design. They also discussed appendix B to the Park Master Plan relating to the ADA Trail and It's My Park Day.

Niccole Maurici stated that she would work with staff to come up with a way to tackle this area with some consistent protocols and that she would bring something back at the next meeting.

8. Discussion and possible action to review private and commercial rate structures and rental fees for Rollingwood Park facilities and Hatley Fields and to make a recommendation to the City Council

Niccole Maurici discussed the current rate structures.

9. Discussion and possible action on a fundraising plan

Niccole Maurici discussed this item, which has been discussed at a prior Park Commission meeting.

Niccole Maurici motioned to table this fundraising plan indefinitely item until the Commission comes up with a park initiative that requires funding. Mary Elizabeth Cofer seconded the motion.

#### The motion passed 5-0.

10. Discussion on the playscape mulch

Niccole Maurici discussed this item, which has been discussed at a previous Park Commission meeting. She also discussed the need for a routine maintenance schedule.

City Administrator Amber Lewis stated that she would have the public works department evaluate the playscape mulch and that staff will keep up with the maintenance.

11. Discussion and possible action regarding reduction or removal of ligustrum tree invasive species in Rollingwood Park

Niccole Maurici discussed this item, which has been discussed at a previous Park Commission meeting.

Don Hudson motioned to table this item to the next meeting and to ask Public Works Operator Vicky Ballard to update the Commission on this effort. Mary Elizabeth Cofer seconded the motion.

#### The motion passed 5-0.

12. Discussion and possible action to add the monthly park walk-through schedule with the scheduled participants to the Rollingwood Park Commission webpage

Niccole Maurici discussed the park walk through schedule and asked for feedback for which dates members can attend.

Assistant City Administrator Ashley Wayman stated that she would send the schedule link out to the Commission and post the schedule to the website at the end of the week.
