#### PRESENTATIONS

2. Discussion and possible action on a presentation from Motive regarding boosting cellular service in Rollingwood

Jonathan Miller discussed a preliminary meeting with Motive regarding options to boost cell service in Rollingwood.

Chris Hogan introduced his the Team from Motive and GenXComm.

Christopher Meakin joined the meeting during this item.

Hardik Jain, with GenXComm, gave a presentation and answered questions from the Commission regarding the options to boost cellular service in the City of Rollingwood.

3. Discussion and possible action on a presentation from Crossroads regarding electronic water meters

Andrew Hunt with Crossroads Utility Service introduced Jeff Walker with Atlas Utility who gave an overview of Atlas Utility and Badger Meters.

City Administrator Amber Lewis discussed the electronic water meter test program that the City undertook with AWR.

Jeff Walker gave a presentation and answered questions from the Commission regarding Badger meters and how the system would work in the City of Rollingwood.

Christopher Meakin motioned to recommend approval of a franchise agreement with the City of Austin with the condition that we will attempt to get more information regarding the maintenance of trees around the lines to the extent they are willing to do so, to review their language and vote on this, and if they say they can't do so then the agreement is approved. Clark Wilson seconded the motion.
